

**MID-SOUTH ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION
D/B/A MIDSOUTH ELECTRIC CO-OP
PREPAID ACCOUNT SERVICE AGREEMENT**

This Prepaid Account Service Agreement (“Agreement”) is attached to and is made a part of the Member’s Electric Service Agreement.

Member requests Prepaid Account Service. Member acknowledges that Member has reviewed Section 4.15, Service Rules and Regulations, of the Cooperative’s Tariff relating to Prepaid Accounts. Member agrees to the provisions in the Tariff relating to Prepaid Accounts and requests the Cooperative create a Prepaid Account for Member.

1. For and in consideration of the Premises, Member agrees as follows:
 - a. Member’s initial credit balance must be at least \$50.00 to set up a Prepaid Account.
 - b. Member’s credit balance is used to pay for electric Service and other appropriate charges related to the electric Service delivered to Member’s POD.
 - c. All purchases of electric Service will be through the Prepaid Account created for the Member and held by the Cooperative.
 - d. Member authorizes the Cooperative to debit against the Member’s credit balance to pay for electric Service rendered, including any availability charge, Energy charge, WPCA, fees, taxes, and other agreed upon billing services, up to and including the entire credit balance in the Prepaid Account.
 - e. Member will receive electric Service only for so long as there are funds available in the Member’s credit balance.
 - f. The Availability Charge continues to accumulate on a daily basis even if the electric Meter is de-activated and no electric Service is being used at the Member’s POD.
 - g. Member accepts and agrees to be bound by all the terms of the Tariff and specifically Section 4.15.
 - h. The Tariff requires a minimum credit balance of \$20.00 in readily available funds to recharge the Member’s Prepaid Account.
 - i. Member will be subject to the FEE SCHEDULE as set out in Section VII to this Tariff.
 - j. Member **WAIVES** the application of Section 4.13(II). of the Tariff, disconnection protection provisions, and acknowledges that a Prepaid Account Member is not entitled to any of those protections afforded a Postpaid Cooperative Member account by the Tariff.
 - k. **Member will be subject to IMMEDIATE DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE if the Member fails to maintain a positive balance in the Member’s Prepaid Account.**
 - l. **Member WAIVES all claims or causes of action against the Cooperative for damages to property and injury to persons, including death, that may result from the Cooperative’s DISCONTINUANCE OF ELECTRIC SERVICE to a Prepaid Account due to the Member’s failure to maintain a positive credit balance in the Prepaid Account.**

2. **Member’s Liability.**

The Member assumes liability for and agrees to HOLD HARMLESS the Cooperative, its directors, officers, employees, and agents for any and all damages of every kind resulting from a discontinuance of service under the Tariff. The Cooperative’s LIABILITY is LIMITED as provided herein and in its Tariff.
